Primary Duties

- Develop and implement a robust community outreach program to increase awareness and build relationships with community organizations, businesses, schools, and churches.
- Represent St. Ann's at community outreach events.
- Maintain a record of all community outreach efforts including name of company, number of attendees and any follow up needed.
- Prepare monthly report of community outreach efforts including statistics and other relevant information.
- Assist in the creation of materials for outreach and volunteer recruitment, working with the Marketing Communications Manager and Program Directors.
- Recruit, screen, train, manage and evaluate all individuals and groups providing volunteer services at St. Ann's.
- Coordinate the volunteer application process assuring proper paperwork and clearances are completed.
- Conduct annual staff training for purposes of understanding the role of volunteers and staff responsibilities for supervision.
- Identify volunteer opportunities in conjunction with Directors and evaluate the volunteer's service.
- Maintain communication with Directors about volunteer schedules, volunteer and donation needs, and volunteer conduct.
- Direct the development of appropriate recognition, retention and motivational programs for volunteers, including an annual recognition event.
- Support a welcoming and positive environment for volunteers.
- Maintain a database of volunteers, track number of volunteers, and donated hours of service; keep a log of all volunteer inquiries and respond within 72 hours.
- Assist with the acquisition of in-kind donations through community outreach and volunteer efforts.
- Accept and complete other duties as assigned.
